**Environmental** Regulation

The agency is responsible for guaranteeing environmental protection during exploration and production; industrial

**Responsibilities:** processing; storage and distribution; and commercialization of

hydrocarbons.

Oil Spill Response: The Agency has to define technical elements that shall be

included in protocols for emergency response, critical risk situations, and events that can cause harm to people, facilities and the environment. It shall participate in such protocols under

coordination of the competent authority (Mexican Navy,

Secretaría de Marina).

ASEA requires that activities in the hydrocarbon's sector are performed under Safety and Environmental Management Systems (SEMS). This instrument is authorized by ASEA. Operators must reflect in that document that they have emergency response plans and oil spill response plans when

applicable.
