



UKCS Workforce Dynamics Review

- Launched in May assesses changing skills requirements over the next 20 years
- Research in partnership with RGU's Oil & Gas Institute
- Roadmap to a new skills strategy

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Key findings

 Successful delivery of Vision 2035 and the wider energy diversification is key and will secure over 1 million boe/day by 2035



- Opportunity to sustain over 130,000 roles from 2035
- Likely recruitment requirement for over 40,000 people including 10,000 in posts that don't exist today in data roles, robotics etc
- Closer collaboration is required between industry and training providers to up-skill and reskill the workforce and ensure we can compete for the best candidates
